

1 opportunity for public comment on the studies, that
2 the activities expressly authorized under the Outer
3 Continental Shelf Lands Act (43 U.S.C. 1331 et
4 seq.) are significantly affecting the air quality of any
5 State for purposes of compliance with the national
6 ambient air quality standards, pursuant to, as re-
7 quired by section 5(a)(8) of such Act (43 U.S.C.
8 1334(a)(8)); and

9 (3) consults with the affected coastal states (as
10 that term is used in that Act) on the results of such
11 studies and analyses, and any actions that may be
12 taken including any incremental burdens on such
13 coastal states that may result.

14 (b) REPROPOSAL OF REGULATIONS.—The Secretary
15 shall—

16 (1) before issuing any such final regulations—

17 (A) repropose the regulations; and

18 (B) provide a period of at least 180 days
19 for the submission of public comment on such
20 reproposed regulations; and

21 (2) delay the effective date of such final regula-
22 tions for at least 180 days after the date they are
23 published.
